Memorandum of Understanding

Widener University and West Nottingham Academy


Through this memorandum, we articulate and codify the ways this partnership can support and advance access to high quality education at the high school and post-secondary levels. The components of our partnership include, but are not limited to:


- Widener University will guarantee admission and a four-year renewable scholarship to graduates of West Nottingham Academy who enroll as a freshman at Widener University. In addition to meeting the general admission requirements of Widener University, and any specific requirements of the program(s) to which they are applying. In general, the applicant must have a minimum 3.25 cumulative GPA, as calculated by the university. Students who meet the above criteria will receive a merit-based scholarship valued minimally at \$100,000 over four years.
- If applying for direct entry to a selective academic program, additional academic achievement reflected on the high school transcript, as well as possible SAT or ACT scores and a submitted application essay may be requested as part of the application review.
- The student must be enrolled on a full-time basis and maintain good academic standing while enrolled at Widener University. The award may only be received for eight consecutive semesters. In addition, students must remain in good standing (social and academic) as well as make satisfactory academic progress toward their degree. The Widener University/West Nottingham Academy Scholarship is not transferable to other institutions.
- West Nottingham Academy will permit a Widener University admission representative to visit with their students as many as three times annually for the purposes of sharing information about the Widener University academic programs and application, admission, financial aid, and related processes. The Widener University representative will arrange visits through the West Nottingham Academy counseling office.
- West Nottingham Academy will display Widener University information, including posters, pennants, and brochures, in the Guidance office or elsewhere at the high school where college information is presented. In addition, if appropriate, this admission and scholarship opportunity shall be displayed on the West Nottingham Academy website with a Widener University logo.

This agreement may be reviewed and revised at any time at the request of the West Nottingham Academy President or Principal or the President or Vice president for Enrollment Management at Widener University.




